- The Bachelor of Religious Education (BRE) is an undergraduate degree that incorporates biblical knowledge, spiritual formation, and academic expertise in teaching by exposing you to the principles, methods & approaches involved in teaching.
- The BRE program will prepare you for a successful career in school settings (e.g. teaching K-8), church ministries (i.e., as effective youth pastors) or parachurch ministries (e.g., counselors, crisis workers, etc.).
- The BRE program transforms graduates into Christian leaders and educators who function as light in increasing darkness, as healers in a broken and hurting world.

PURPOSE & BENEFITS:

- The purpose of the BRE degree is to, as Proverbs 22:6 says, "train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it." As a result, the goal of this degree program is to equip congregants of local churches in the province of Ontario with the proper training to start private Christian schools and teach K-8.
- The benefit of the BRE is that it trains teachers to instill proper Christian values in children under their care by offering them a robust, wholesome education and counselling them to navigate difficult moral and ethical issues. In this way, BRE graduates are guardians of the next generation, protecting them from the perverse teachings of most "modern" schools, and equipping them to fulfill their God-given potential.

- The BRE program offers high biblical and academic standards, highly
 qualified instructors, a low instructor to student ratio, and a personalized
 program, particularly in relation to research projects.
- The BRE program provides a challenging curriculum with a balanced course load of theology, general studies, and teacher-training seminars (with NEW teacher-training courses such as Designing Curriculum & Developing Lesson Plans, Methods & Approaches to Teaching First & Second Language Learners, & Field Education being added within the next year!)

TUITION & SCHOLARSHIP

Our goal at CCC is to promote excellence in our students which is why we are happy to offer scholarships and financial support opportunities to them.
